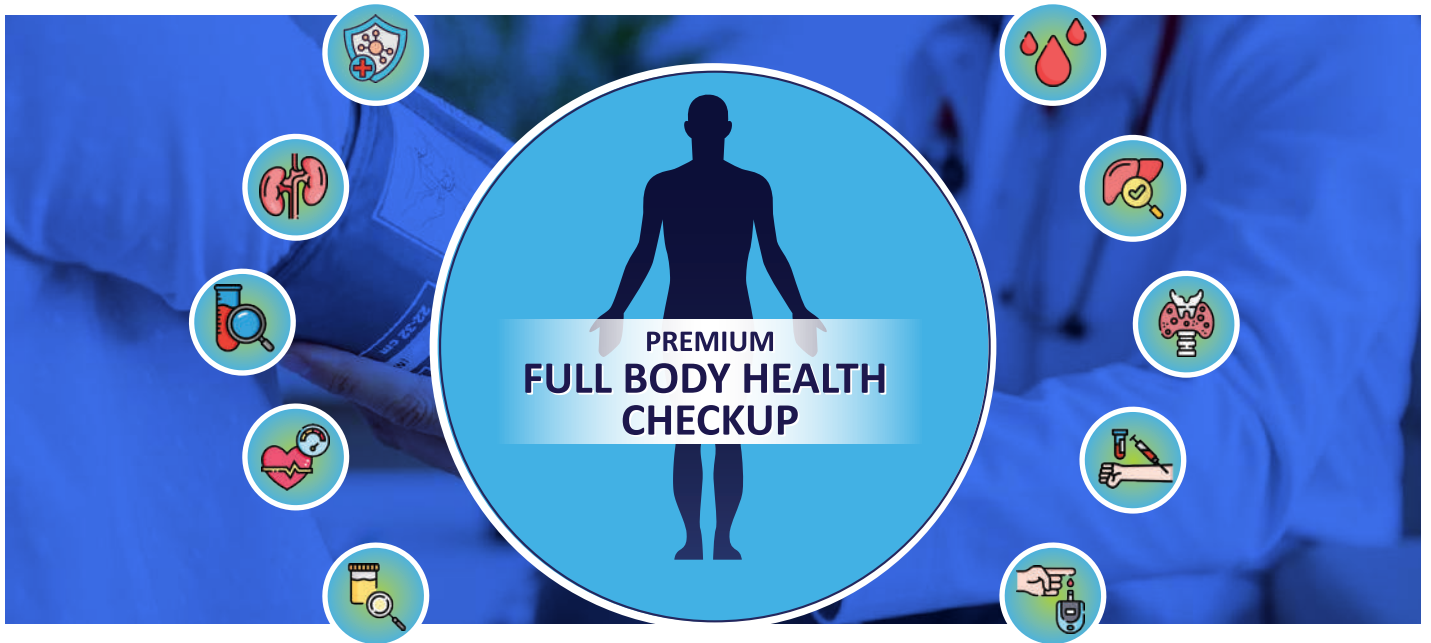

TSH is produced by the pituitary gland in your brain and sent to the thyroid gland. This would help in diagnosis of Hypothyroidism and Hyperthyroidism in patients.

Fasting blood glucose tests are frequently prescribed by medical professionals to check for diabetes. Fasting blood glucose tests provide a more accurate picture of your baseline blood sugar because eating food impacts blood sugar levels. An HbA1c test result must be less than 5.7% in order to be considered normal or in the non-diabetic category. A person can be diagnosed with diabetes if their HbA1c is 6.5% or higher, but prediabetes are defined as anyone with a value between 5.7% and 6.4%.

Don'ts

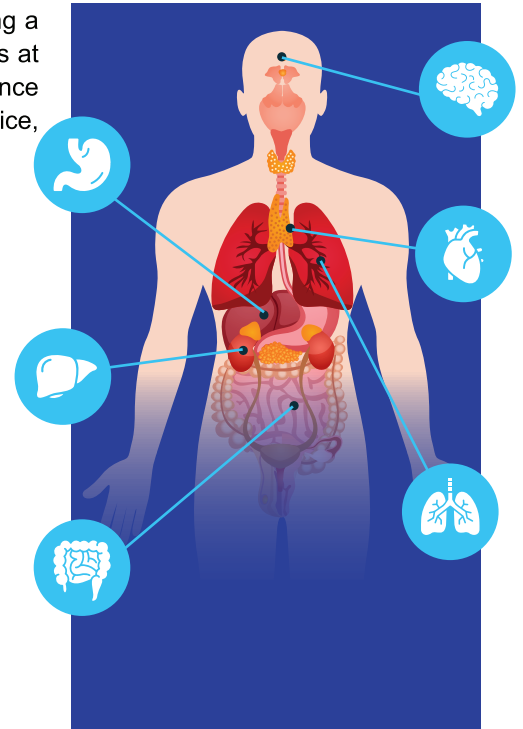
Avoid consuming a large meal right before your visit. Before seeing the doctor, go on an empty stomach or eat a small breakfast or lunch.

Don't overindulge in liquids several hours prior to your visit. This can make it difficult for doctors to acquire an accurate reading of your blood pressure, as eating excess liquid can create false rises in blood pressure.
